Covid 19.

The situation regarding the pandemic is difficult to predict. The Norwegian air-sports federation and F3A Norway are acting based on advice given by the national institute of public health. The Nordic championship will be cancelled IF we are advised to do so. Information about an eventually cancellation will be given in a bulletin not later than 8 weeks before the championship. (In the end of week 22)

1. Introduction F3A Nordic Championship 2021

F3A Norway and the Norwegian airsports-federation (NLF) in cooperation with the host club Aurskog Høland model-airplane club proudly welcomes you to participate in the F3A Nordic Championship 2021, held at the clubs airport east of Oslo Norway. Date for the event is set to 29th of July until 1.august. This bulletin contains the basic information about the contest. More information will become available in later bulletins.

After all team registration forms have been received there will be a Bulletin No.2 with additional information.

2. General Information

The general rules in the FAI Sporting Code regarding model dimensions and weight will be used. Failsafe function and pilots sporting license will have to be verified during model control prior to the contest. Marking and model certificate according to the sporting code will not be required.

The "Common rules for Nordic championships F3A and Nordic" will also be followed.

The P-21 schedule will be flown in the preliminary four F3A rounds and the F-21 schedule will be flown in the last two final F3A rounds.

In the Nordic class the N-21 Nordic schedule will be flown in all four rounds.

3. Location

The competition site, Aurskog Høland, is located east-southeast of Oslo.

4. Participating teams

This Bulletin will be sent out to the following countries: Finland, Denmark, Norway, and Sweden. At the championship, each country has the possibility of entering both an F3A team and a Nordic team. There will be a team and an individual competition in both the F3A and Nordic classes. Each participating country can enter the following teams:

F3A:

One team consisting of 3 senior-pilots and 2 junior-pilots. The junior pilots could be substituted by 2 seniors who will then be counted as open participants.

In addition to the above mentioned team, the reigning F3A Nordic Champion Mr.Lassi Nurila from Finland will be invited. He will be regarded as an open participant if he chooses to participate and therefore he will not count as part of the national team ranking.

Nordic:

- Up to 4 pilots. The three (3) best individual results for each team will count towards the team competition.

In the Nordic class, all 4 participants will, however, receive awards as team members. In both classes the 3 best individual total scores will count as the team result and be awarded.

Each F3A competitor and team manager must own a FAI Sporting License valid for 2021. This license must be registered in the FAI licenses database. The holder of a FAI sporting license may be required to produce an official document bearing his/her photograph and signature as proof of identity.

5. Radio Frequencies

We assume all competitors will be using 2.4GHz, but 35.000 - 35.220 MHz is also allowed.

6. Transmitter Impound

The transmitters will not be stored by the organizers during the contest.

7. Noise Check

The noise limit is 94 dB (A).

8. Judges

F3A pilots and Nordic pilots will both fly in front of a panel of five judges.

In the F3A class, Denmark, Finland, and Sweden have to provide 1 judge each. Norway will provide 2 judges, TBL will be used throughout the competition in both classes. There will be minimum 2 preflights for both P21& F21 prior to the competition. Pre-flights for N-21 will be evaluated based on judge request. We will use the Noutamatic scoring boards and all judges have to understand how Noutamatic works prior to the contest.

The panel of judges will do 4 P-21 rounds and 2 F-21 rounds and have to consist of the same judges throughout the whole competition.

In the Nordic class, Denmark, Finland, and Sweden have to provide 1 pilot (Norway 2 pilots) each from the F3A class or a competent non-pilot judge to form a panel of judges. It is up to each country to decide if their judge will be the same person through all rounds or if a change of judge will occur between each round.

The panel of judges will be:

F3A class:

- 1 judge from Finland
- 2 judges from Norway
- 1 judge from Sweden
- 1 judge from Denmark

Nordic class:

1 judge from Finland (F3A pilot or enlisted person)

2 judges from Norway (F3A pilot or enlisted person)

1 judge from Sweden (F3A pilot or enlisted person)

1 judge from Denmark (F3A pilot or enlisted person)

The judges will have to review a judges briefing, where they will get the required information.

9. Accommodation

Hotels

There are normally several events in the area during the summer.
